Rules & Regulations

Honors

Eligibility criteria

- **Design projects done individually by design students** are only **eligible**. Group projects are not eligible for this Award.
- You must be a design student pursuing your undergraduate or postgraduate studies or a recent design graduate (graduated on or before 1 Jan 2021) from a recognised design school.
- Only projects which span a duration of 3-6 months are eligible.
- The project may be any classroom project, passion project or your graduation project which aligns with any one of the award categories.
- Resent graduates having more than 2 years of experience are not eligible.
- The evaluation will be based solely on the material and information provided by the applicant in the form while submitting their entries.
- Incomplete entries to be disqualified.
- Current interns and employees of ValueLabs are not eligible to participate

Submission

The program is structured in 2 phases:

Phase 1: Registration & round-1 of shortlisting

- Description of the project briefly (75-100 words)
- Detailed project description (1000-1500 words)
- Award Category
- 10 images describing project and process
- Video (optional but highly recommended)
- Supporting doc additional any document
- Resume
- Proof- Student ID or graduation certificate

Accepted formats

- File naming format: Firstname Lastname_Project Title
 - E.g. Vaishali Vashisht_Xyz Website Redesign

Phase 2: Jury round and final selection

The shortlisted candidates are notified, and submission instructions are provided for the jury round, as mentioned below-

Project Video- Briefly describe your project, design concept and features. You can show or explain the working of the prototype in a particular scenario

A video file up to 5 mins (mandatory): MP4 format, max 25MB in size

Project Poster- A3 poster presenting your project and concept

Eligibility criteria

In addition to the requirements listed above, all entries must meet the following general standards:

- Your entry must be your own original work.
- You must have obtained all consents and given due credits to secondary stakeholders and people who helped you.
- The content of your entry and any supporting materials must be acceptable for all viewing audiences. We will automatically disqualify any entrant that submits any entry or supporting materials that contain content that we find obscene or offensive, violent, defamatory, disparaging, or illegal, or that promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, or a particular political agenda, or that communicates messages that may reflect hate, negativity.
